

an arbitrator, upon being notified to do so by the Council aforesaid, by writing a letter to that effect, addressed to him, her or them, at his or their last, or then present residence, and by publication of such notice for one month in one Port Sarnia newspaper, then and in that case, after the 5 expiration of thirty days from the time of such notice being fully completed, the Judge of the County Court of the County of Lambton shall act as arbitrator for such party or parties so refusing or neglecting, and the said Judge shall, with the other two arbitrators, as hereinbefore provided, proceed to adjudge and determine the damages or purchase money, or 10 other matter or thing submitted to their judgment, according to the provisions of this Act.

IV. The whole sum expended and to be expended by the said Council in making and completing the said works, and the payment of such damages as aforesaid, shall not exceed Two Thousand Pounds, and 15 may be raised by the said Municipal Council by rate or loan, at such times and in such proportions as the said Municipal Council shall deem fitting, but subject otherwise to the provisions of Law touching the raising of monies by Municipalities by rate or loan as the case may be.

Cost of works limited: Council may raise the requisite money by loan or rate.

V. The said Council shall have power to acquire from the Crown and to 20 hold any land the property of the Crown now covered by the waters of the said Lake Wawanosh; and on the completion of the said works the said Council shall sell such portions thereof as may have been drained and rendered fit for cultivation at public auction to the highest bidder, in lots not exceeding 100 acres each, and shall have full power to convey the 25 same to the purchaser, his heirs and assigns in fee, and the proceeds of said sale shall belong to the Municipal Council of the Township of Sarnia for general Municipal purposes.

Council may acquire the land drained and sell it.

VI. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
