In all other respects, all the provisions of the Municipal Cor-Municipal Corporations Acts of Upper Canada, giving such privileges, and making porations Acts provision for the payment of the amounts appropriated, whether to be other respects. borrowed upon a loan, or to be raised by direct taxation, shall be ad-20 hered to.

IV. The Treasurer of such united Counties shall pay over all sums so Moneys so paid into his hands by the several Collectors without any deduction for raised to be per centage.

The property to be assessed for the purposes of this Act contem- Only property 25 plated shall be the same as is assessed for any other County purpose, in the County except that any sum to be raised for the purposes of one County only, be assessed. or for the payment of any debt contracted for the purposes of one County cnly, shall be assessed and levied solely upon property in that County, and not upon that in the other or others united to it.
