An Act to naturalize Pulaski Clark.

W HEREAS Pulaski Clark, residing at Byng Inlet in the Dis-Framble. trict of Parry Sound and Dominion of Canada, merchant, has by his Petition represented that he is desirous of becoming a permanent resident of the said Dominion, and in order to be relieved from the legal disabilities under which as an alien he labors, has prayed that he may be naturalized as a subject of Her most gracious Majesty, and whereas it is expedient to grant his prayer; Therefore, Her Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :--

- 10 1. The said Pulaski Clark shall be deemed, adjudged and taken P. Clark to have obtained all the rights, capacities and privileges of a natural naturalized. born British subject within the Dominion of Canada, and to have, hold and possess and enjoy the same within the limits thereof, upon from and after the passing of this Act; provided always, that the Proviso.
- 15 said Pulaski Clark shall within three months after the passing of this Act, take and subscribe before the Judge of the County Court of the County of Sincoe or York, who is hereby authorized and directed to administer the same, the oath of allegiance to Her Majesty, Her heirs and successors, and such oath so taken and sub-
- 20 scribed, shall be transmitted by such Judge to the Secretary of State for Canada, to be kept by him amongst the Records of his Office.
