An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain sums of money for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government for the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Three, for the cost of certain Public Works, and for certain other expenses connected with the Public Service.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,

WHEREAS by Messages from His Excellency the Right Honorable James, Earl of Elgin and Kincardine, Gover-nor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over this Province of Canada, bearing date respectively the Thirty-First day of May and the Eleventh day of June, in the year One Thousand Eight landred and Fifty-Three, and the Estimates accompanying the same, laid before both Houses of the Provincial Parliament, appears that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Civil Government of this Province for the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Three, not otherwise provided for by law, and also for defraying the Cost of certain Public Works, and for other phrposes in the said Message and Estimates mentioned: "y it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, In Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and out of any unappropiated moneys forming part of the Consolidated Revenue -fund of this Province, there shall and may be paid and applied um not exceeding in the whole the sum of Five Hundred and Sixty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine \_\_\_\_\_\_5, Nineteen Shillings and Two Pence currency, for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of this Province, for the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Two, and other purposes, set forth in the Schedule to this Act.
