power to suspend or dismiss any such Teacher, if he shall consider it necessary to do so, and to appoint any person to be a Teacher to any vacancy which the Trustees may refuse or neglect to fill up within thirty days after he shall have notified them of the same; and also, to make and enforce any regulations he may see fit to make for the administration of such Schools.

XXXIX. And be it enacted, That whenever a Normal Teachers to be School shall be in operation in Upper Canada, no person shall Principal of be appointed to be a principal Teacher in any District Model Normal School School, who shall not have produced to the District Superin-lished. tendent a Certificate of qualification and ability, signed by the principal or Head Master of such Normal School.
