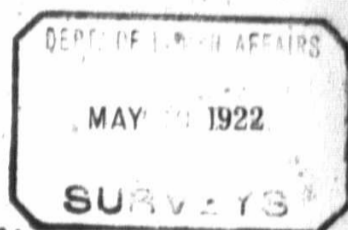

With reference to yours of the 8th instant,
file 22114-3, I wish to advise that the tie referred to, namely
391.2 feet, extends from the North East corner of Section 24 to
the centre line of railway and not to the iron post shown at
57.5 feet from the centre line. No change was made in this
tie when the plans were last in this office.

be in a position to approve of tracings, and I shall be pleased
to receive the same at the earliest possible date.
