In reply to your letter of the 18th instant,
inquiring as to whether you can cut hardwood for sale
which has been blown down or cut in clearing land, I
have to inform you that the Indian Agent has been in-
structed to issue permits to Indians of the Thessalon
Band to cut and sell cordwood subject to dues at 20 cents
per cord of 128 cubic feet, under sworn returns, and you
should apply to him.
