work and not hold up the sea plane after the treaty payments are completed.

I note that the medical officer will be allowed \$10.00 per day on the Nelson House trip for acting in his official capacity outside the limits of his territory.

Does the Department intend me to act as Agent at Nelson, Churchill and York Factory? I have to be careful in this as the Corporal is acting Agent out there and has things well in hand. If I go as Agent I will have to give decisions on many subjects on which I am not at least familar, whereas if I go as clerk I can allow the Corporal to carry on as usual. It will not hurt my feelings in the least to do this, but it would probably work to the detriment of the work of the Indian Department if we slight the Corporal.
