Sir:-

With reference to previous correspondence regarding the taking of the Indian census, I beg to say that Mr. Frank Doyle is being appointed Acting Indian Agent for the Indians at Pointe Equinox and vicinity while Dr. C.A. McDougall of Seven Islands is being appointed Acting Indian Agent for the Indians of Seven Islands and Moisie. Their services will be available in connection with the taking of the Indian census in the districts referred to. (I may here remark that the whole district is referred to on the list sent you headed "Quebec" and marked Seven Islands to Natashquan, excluding Natashquan).

In letter of the 16th May, it was intimated that it might be well for you to appoint an enumerator for the taking of the Indian census in Richmond County, N.S. as Mr. McKillan has resigned and a new appointment has not been made.

You were also informed in letter of the 16th May of the resignation of Mr. R.C. Macdonald of New Westminster, and of the appointment of his successor in office, Mr. Peter Byrne.

The services of Mr. E.H. Bennett, Battleford, Sask. will be available to take the census in the district known as Treaty No. 10. It falls within the North Saskatchewan Inspectorate.

Mr. John Watson of Selkirk has been placed in charge of the Indians of Fisher Drive Division vice Mr. John Semmens and his services will be available for taking the census in that district.
