

# THE VETERANS

**LIEUT. COL. W. E. SEABORN**

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**LANCE CORPL. T. MITCHELL**

King's South African Medal.

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**PRIVATE GEORGE JONES**

Served 16 years Grenadier Guards, 2½ years; in South Africa under General Francis Lloyd in the 8th Division (Rundell's Greyhounds). Wounded at Seneka. Holds King's and Queen's S. A. Medals and 5 clasps.

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**SERGEANT J. E. OVER**

Enlisted January, 1901 in S. A. Constabulary; served 5 years in that force, and was in charge Villiers district in Orange River Colony, in 1906 when Zulu Rebellion broke out. Joined Natal Carbiniers. Returned to Canada 1908. Has Natal Medal, King's S. A. Medal (2 bars), and Queen's S. A. Medal (4 bars).

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**SERGEANT HAWES**

Enlisted 1894 1st Volunteer Battalion Suffolk Regiment. Grenadier Guards 1896. Served in Egypt under Lord Kitchener; present at Khartoum, 1898. Khedive Medal and clasp, Khartoum and Queen Victoria's Soudan Medal. Total service 19 years. Wears Canadian Veterans' Medal.

**DRUM MAJOR H. W. CANT**

Enlisted Royal Fusiliers (7th Foot) 1894. Served throughout S. A. War and was at Colenso. Relief of Ladysmith, Battle of Tugela Heights. Relief of Kimberley; at latter end of war was in Flying Column attached to 5th Irish Lancers. Holds Army and Navy Veteran Medal. Queen's S. A. Medal and 5 bars, King's S. A. Medal and 2 bars.

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**R. Q. M. S. J. W. HOPKINS**

Enlisted at Manchester in Cavalry of the Line; served in Ireland, 1898; attached to 9th Lancers, Multra, India, 1899; served in South Africa and wounded five times; Acting School Master in Regimental School, India, 1902-05; Chief Clerk to A. A. G. 2nd Rawal Pindi Division, India.

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**PROVOST SERGT. C. W. McGEE**

Enlisted Royal West Kent Regiment (old 97th Foot); served Zu'u Campaign (1 clasp); Bombardment of Alexandria under Lord Charles Beresford; Battle of Tel-el-Kebir (Queen's Egyptian Medal 2 clasps and Khedive Star); also Canadian Veterans' Medal.

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**CORPL. J. BUTTER**

Served 11½ years Imperial army in A.S.C. in Egypt and Malta and R.M.C. South Africa. Has four medals, two Egyptian with 3 bars, and King's and Queen's S. A. Medal with 4 bars.
