

and the Bill to authorize the construction of a Tramway or Railroad from the Village of *Orangeville*, in the County of *Wellington*, to some point on the Grand Trunk Railway west of *Toronto*, and have severally amended the same, which they humbly submit for the consideration of Your Honorable House.

Your Committee have also considered the Bill to further amend the Act to incorporate the International Bridge Company, and have agreed to report the same, without any amendment.

The Honorable Mr. *McDougall*, one of Her Majesty's Executive Council, presented, pursuant to an Address to His Excellency the Governor General,—Return to an Address of the Legislative Assembly, dated 18th July, 1866; for a copy of all correspondence and contracts since 1st May, 1864, relative to a change of proprietors of the *Beauport* Lunatic Asylum, and the support of the lunatics in the said Asylum. (*Sessional Papers*, No. 44.)

The Order of the Day for the third reading of the Bill to amend and extend the provisions of the Act incorporating the *Port Hope, Lindsay and Beaverton* Railway Company and the Acts amending the same, being read;

*Ordered*, That the said Order be discharged.

*Ordered*, That the Bill be now re-committed to a Committee of the whole House.

The House, accordingly resolved itself into the said Committee; and after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; and Mr. *Street* reported, That the Committee had gone through the Bill, and made amendments thereunto.

*Ordered*, That the Report be now received.

Mr. *Street* reported the Bill accordingly, and the amendments were read and agreed to.

*Ordered*, That the Bill be now read the third time.

The Bill was accordingly read the third time.

*Resolved*, That the Bill do pass.

*Ordered*, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

A Bill to incorporate the *Globe* Printing Company, was according to Order, read a third time.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. *McDougall*, seconded by the Honorable Mr. *Rose*, the Bill was amended, by adding the following clause thereto: "The corporate rights hereby conferred, shall at all times hereafter be subject to the provisions of any general enactment hereafter to be passed respecting incorporated Companies."

*Resolved*, That the Bill do pass.

*Ordered*, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

A Bill to incorporate the Ecclesiastical Society of *St. John*, of the Diocese of *Kingston*, was according to Order, read the third time.

*Resolved*,—That the Bill do pass and the title be, "An Act to incorporate the Ecclesiastical Society of *St. John*, in the Roman Catholic Diocese of *Kingston*."

*Ordered*, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

A Bill to incorporate the *Institut des Artisans Canadiens* of *Montreal*, was according to Order, read the third time.

*Resolved*, That the Bill do pass, and the title be "An Act to incorporate the *Institut des Artisans Canadiens de Montréal*."

*Ordered*, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

The House according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee on the Bill to make valid the Will of *George Desbarats*, in *Upper Canada*; on the Bill to incorporate the Board of Trade of the City of *London*; on the Bill to authorize the Corporation of *St. Vincent*, to construct a harbor and impose dues, and for other purposes; on the Bill to amend the
