\*{\*\*} HEREAS it is thought expedient that every Kind of R W R Cea shall be subject to the same Duty.

I. Be it Enacted by the Governor Council and Asfembly. That from and after the First day of July, 1771, there shall be paid on all Teas fold, or by any Ways or Means brought into this Province, for every pound of fuch. Tea, one Shilling, in Lieu of the former Duty of Excise on Green Tea and Bohea Tea.

Excise on Tea one Shilling per pound.

II. And be it also Enaked, That an Act made in the Tenth Year of his Present Majesty's Reign, intitled an Att for granting to His agaiean an Excise on Tea, Coffee and playing Cards, sold within or brought into this Province, with the Alteration thereto made by this Act shall be and continue, and the same is hereby continued in Force from the Expiration thereof, until the First Day of July, 1772.
