

An Indian Cabin on the Best!

(From the Friday River Correspondent.)

It was the Friday River Correspondent who, on Christmas Eve, 1883, gave a number of us assembled in a comfortable, old-fashioned farm-house. It had been snowing all day, and we were getting hard up for amusement. About the middle of the afternoon the storm ceased. Then one of the party mentioned an old Indian fortune-teller, who had recently settled a short distance from us, and another suggested that Friday was his best day for telling fortunes, and a trip to his cabin was accordingly discussed. But some preferred the fire and their "Franklin Squares," to waiting thro' deep snow in quest of the aborigine, and only four volunteers were found, two of each sex.

The short December afternoon was drawing to its close as we started, plunging through snow that was almost knee deep. Then we turned off the road and up a hill, among evergreens loaded with snow, making our own path, for we were the first to travel in that direction, for that day at least.

At length we came in sight of the Indian habitation, and really it was a picture of a sight. A log house of about 12 x 16. Its greatest height was about 6 feet. About one-third of the roof was level, the sides sloped and the extremities were about four feet from the ground. Through a hole in the roof a stove pipe projected. There was a door in the middle of the end fronting us. Windows there were none. About two rods away was a similar structure which I found was the barn. The roofs of both were loaded with snow, and the path was as good as well as the main road, was completely obscured by spruce and hemlock. Before the cabin door was the old Melicote of whom we were in search. He was chopping at an immense log, and pretended not to notice our approach.

We attended his attention and made known our errand. Then followed several objections. First, he hadn't time. There was his wood to be split. Upon this one of the gentlemen said he would chop the log up, and forthwith set to work at it. Soon the log was divided in halves, and the halves quartered, the old Indian standing by and repeating his "ya-gum." After that we combated the other difficulties. He hadn't a new pack of cards; his spectacles were broken; it was too late in the day, and so forth. In about half an hour we won his consent, and then he wanted an exorbitant price, which we refused, and after some more arguing it was agreed to split the difference. Then we were admitted to the cabin. We had to stoop as we entered the door, which was securely latched after us. There was only one room in the dwelling. It had a nicely planed wood floor, and rags were stuffed in between the logs to keep the wind out. A large stove in the centre kept the place warm, and the large square hole in the roof served as a ventilator, and probably let in light during the day. Shelves were all in the corners, and everywhere else where there was room for one. Nails and hooks were also abundantly dispersed, and in several places long poles were slung up, as if for drying. There were also some of the family, as well as their cooking utensils, were kept off the floor, and the whole interior had a tidy look. The bedding was rolled up and stowed away in a dark corner, and several pairs of boots were hung up by the heels. The space above the floor was making moccasins, with their heads adorned with red or yellow handkerchiefs. A small table at the end of the cabin, opposite the door, held a lamp, which gave out a "dim religious light." Two boxes and a small bench were brought out for us to sit on, while "Toan," as they called the Indian, began stuffing his pipe. What a picture he would have made, with his leathery expression and his little shrewd black eyes! He was short and thick-set. Had any of the family been tall they would have found difficulty in walking about the room. Presently he asked whose should be the first. They all said the Indian, and he got down on a box beside the table, a little nervous, it must be confessed, till I discovered what meant someone he was telling. We had a good deal of amusement, however, while the four fortunes were being given over, asking him all sorts of questions, and making the most absurd statements. Then we made our adieux and went out in the dusk, down hill, through deep snow, and amidst the gloomy evergreens. When we reached the main road the walking was not much better, and it was quite dark before we got home. We didn't believe our fortunes "Honest Injun."

He told us all something different, but the gist of them was the same—"rich time" and "plenty of money," "money everywhere."

The Indians of the Miramichi call the 2nd of January their New Year's Day. They march around from store to store, and from house to house, carrying flags and firing salutes, wishing the people a "Happy New Year," and expecting money, clothes or provisions. If these are not forthcoming they are very indignant, and are not at all backward in expressing some very uncompromising opinions.

ST. JOHN, January 7.
SKATING.—St. John is well supplied with skating rinks, no less than three being now in full running. The best of these being the past few days excellent skating on Lily Lake. It is really surprising to see the very large numbers that go skating in the afternoon, both male and female, and it makes one wonder how all these people get a living. Take last Friday and Saturday as an instance. The Carleton was well attended, the Marsh Road rink was well attended, and Lily Lake was thronged with a merry party.

FIRE AND ACCIDENT.—On Friday morning about 8:45 a fire broke out in the smoke-house of Messrs. Noble Bros' fish curing establishment, British street. The morning was very cold, but the fire brigade responded with their usual promptness, and the fire was confined to the building. The building and stock was insured in the Commercial Insurance Company for \$1,500 and the loss is estimated slightly above that figure. The fire will not interfere to a large extent with the firm's business operations. The driver of No. 2 horse reel, on his way to the fire, and when going at a terrific speed, the whistling broke, he being thrown to the ground and dragged some distance. His injuries are reported quite serious.

CITY COURT.—At the opening of the Circuit Court on Tuesday last, His Honor Judge Fraser in his address to the Grand Jury made what seems to be a very sensible remark in regard to criminals convicted under the Criminal Laws of Canada, namely, that the Dominion should bear all the costs of imprisonment, etc. His Honor remarked that he had for a long time labored for a change to express such an opinion, and that was his first opportunity of doing so. Certainly the remarks of the learned Judge have caused a sensation in them, and the authorities would do well to carefully look into Judge Fraser's remarks. He also congratulated St. John on the absence of crime of any serious character. There were two criminal cases entered, Peterson, charged with stealing a watch, for which charge the Grand Jury found no bill, the other, McNally, of Portland, charged with stealing parcels from Barnes & Co's sleigh, in which case the Grand Jury found a true bill. Their trial will in all probability take place this week. John Kerr, Esq., appears in their behalf and the Solicitor General for the Crown.

RELIGIOUS.—A meeting of the St. John Presbytery was held last Tuesday. The call of Rev. Mr. Berio to Florenceville, and Glassville was sustained. It was directed that all Sabbath School correspondence should be forwarded to Rev. Mr. Forthright. The Week of Prayer was held that week, and each meeting was largely attended. A juvenile missionary meeting was held in Trinity Church school room last Tuesday, at which Mr. C. G. Roberts, of your city, was one of the foremost speakers.

The latter's showed an increase of sales as compared with 1882, and in fact all the reports showed the Society to be doing greatly. In March last the Society reported to the Parent Society \$2000 sterling, which is the largest sum ever given by any Society on the American continent. Towards evening, the Carleton Branch Society held its annual meeting Friday evening, and very encouraging reports were also made.
