

### Sammary of Budget Taxation Proposals

Ottawa, May 18-The following i summary of the taxation proposals ubmitted to Parliament by the Minister of Finance this afternoon

Luxury Taxes

Ten per cent. of the total purchas price on boots and shoes costing over \$9.00 a pair; men's and boys su'ts costing over \$45.00 each; men's and women's overcoats costing over \$50 each; fur coats and robes over \$100.00 each; women's dresses costing over \$45; women's suits costing over \$60.00; and on hats, hose, neck ware, shirts, purses and gloves costing above a certain specified figure as well as on some other wearing apparel, all fans, opera cloaks, ivory handled cutlery, cut glass, velvet and silk fabrics, lace, ribbons, silk embroideries, and sporting goods, also on trunks over \$40.00 each and

Beer, wines and spirits —Increase in excise duties on beer of 30 cents

Stamp Duties—Existing tax on cheques continued, but rate increas ed on bills of exchange and promissory notes. Two cents for bills of exchange and promissory notes. Two cents for bills of \$100 or less and two cents for each additional \$100. r fractional pant thereof.

Stamp duties on patent medicines, etc., henceforth to be affixed by man ufacturer or importer instead of retailer as now.

By last year's legislation incomtaxes payable this year on 1919 income were very substantially raised A further general addition to these taxes of five per cent. is now add ed on incomes of \$5,000 and up, to

be affective this year.

In future income tax returns must be accompanied by a check for at least twenty five per cent. 1st the whole of the amount estimated to be payable. If paid in instalments, interest at six per cent. is to be charged and payment in full is required within six months after re-turn is made by means of three equal bi-monthly instalments Heavy penalties are provided for in bi-monthly instalments. correct returns.

Business Profits Tax

Present tax is modified by increa ing /the exemption allowed from seven to ten per cent, and changing the schedule of taxation to the fol-

cent on capital but not exceeding fifteen per cent. the tax will be twenty per cent.
On profits in excess of fifteen

fits exceeding ten per cent will be taken instead of twenty-five per cent as at present.

Under legislation of last session he maximum scale of business tax is in effect this year and the mod. fied tax will apply to 1920 profits taxable in 1921.

Tariff Changes

The seven and a half per cent war customs duty is taken off all re-maining items. Last year the five per cents British preferential war tax was entirely removed as well as the seven and a half on food, clothing, agricultural implements. etc. The war customs duty imposed in 1915 are now entirely removed.

A feature of the luxury tax is its general application. It hits articles of all kinds. Small wares, as well as the more expensive opera cloak, come under the tax. Ten per cent. will be levied on the purchase price of boots in excess of nine dollars per pair, on hats, men's and boys' and boys', in excess of \$2 each; on hose, stockings, silk, men's and boys' in excess of \$1 a pair; on neckties and neckware, men's and boys' in excess of \$1.50 each; waist coats, men's, sold separately from suits, in excess of \$3 each; hats, bonnets and cess of \$12 each; hose, stockings, silk, women's and misses', in excess of \$2 perpair; kimonos, peticandy, confectionery, chewing gum, firearms, shells or cartridges, pianos each; pyjamas and underwear in exeach; pyjamas and underwear in excess of \$5.

in excise duties on beer of 30 cents a gallon; non-sparkling wines, \$2.00 a gallon; sparkling wines; \$3.00 a gallon.

Motor Cars—Excise tax on Canadian manufactured and imported cars increased from ten to fifteen per cent.

Sales Tax—One per cent. on the sales of all manufacturers, wholesale dealers, jobbers or importers (not retailors). This tax not to apply to large list of essential food stuffs, cattle foods and bituminous coal, or to goods exported.

Stamp puttes—Existing tax on cheques continued but rate increase.
