

at least twenty-four hours' notice in writing of the time and place of such meeting.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

23. The President, when in attendance, shall preside at all meetings and shall inform the Club of the proceedings of the Executive Committee since the last report; he shall preserve order and regulate the proceedings of the meeting and discharge the duties usually incident to the office of chairman.

24. The Senior Vice-President, in the absence of the President, and the Junior Vice-President, in the absence of both the President and Senior Vice-President, shall have all the powers and privileges and shall perform all the duties of the President.

25. In the absence of the President and both Vice-Presidents, a chairman for the meeting shall be chosen by the open vote of the members present.

26. The Archivist shall have the custody of all literary matter of the Club, shall edit the publications of the Club, and in a general way promote and guard the interests of the Club in the public press.
