FIRE BRANCH.

The net premiums received during the year 1875 (after deductions for returns and re-assurances) amounted to £200,824, and the losses paid and outstanding to £290,978, being 60 per cent. of the premiums.

After deducting £40,000 carried to Profit and Loss Account, and allowing for all outstanding losses, the Fire Fund on 31st December last, stood at £250,318, as against £216,273 at the corresponding date in the previous year.

LIFE BRANCH.

During the past year, 150 Policies assuring £349,625 were completed; the new premiums being £12,402. The Assurance Fund on the 31st December last, amounted to £446,262, showing an increase of £44,071 during the year.
