The PRESIDENT (translated from Spanish):

... The subsidiary bodies have concluded their work and their reports are being prepared in all the official languages. The report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Chemical Weapons will be ready later than the others, as this Committee concluded its work at the eleventh hour on Tuesday. The English text will be available on Tuesday the 3rd in the morning and the remaining languages first thing on Wednesday the 4th. Owing to the size of remaining languages first that the Committee was not able to conclude its work the report and the fact that the Committee was not able to conclude its work last Monday as planned, it has not been possible to have it available earlier.
