

“insured” means:-

- (i) in relation to Canada, that contributions have been paid, or are payable, by the person concerned under the *Canada Pension Plan* or, as the case may require, the comprehensive pension plan of a province of Canada, and
- (ii) in relation to the United Kingdom, that contributions have been paid by, or are payable by, or in respect of, or have been credited in respect of, the person concerned;

“legislation” means, in relation to a Party, such of the legislation specified in Article 2 as applies in that Party;

“Party” means the United Kingdom or Canada;

“self-employed person” means:-

- (i) in relation to Canada, a person with self-employed earnings, as defined in the *Canada Pension Plan*, and
- (ii) in relation to the United Kingdom, a person who comes within the definition of a self-employed earner or of a self-employed person under the legislation of the United Kingdom, or is treated as such,

and the words “person is self-employed” shall be construed accordingly;

“United Kingdom” means the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and also the Isle of Man.

- (2) Other words and expressions which are used in this Convention have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the legislation concerned.
- (3) Any reference in this Convention to an “Article” means an Article of this Convention, and any reference to a “paragraph” is a reference to a paragraph of the Article in which the reference is made, unless it is stated to the contrary.
