Dear Minister Hockin:

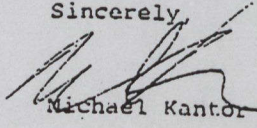
I have the honor to confirm the following understanding reached between the delegations of the United States, Canada and the United Mexican States with respect to Article 104 of the North American Free Trade Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "NAFTA"):

"The Parties to the NAFTA will modify Annex 104.1 of the NAFTA to include the following additional agreements:

- (a) The Convention Between the United States of America and the United Mexican States for the Protection of Migratory Birds and Game Mammals, done at Mexico, February 7, 1936; and
- (b) The Convention on the Protection of Migratory Birds, done at Washington, August 16, 1916."

I have the further honor to propose that this letter, and your letter of confirmation in reply, constitute an agreement between our two governments, to enter into effect upon the entry into force of the NAFTA.
