The Indonesian government announced in early January that, as of September 30, 1997, its foreign debt totalled U.S.\$133.3 billion, U.S.\$65.6 billion of which is owed by the private sector. Recently, South Korea's foreign debt was listed at U.S.\$153 billion, of which 60% (U.S.\$92 billion), was due within one year.
