

Article 17 - (Text of Article 17)

17. (1) Every member of the Council of the Government shall be elected by the House of Commons for a term of office of not more than five years, and shall be eligible for re-election.

(2) The House of Commons may determine the conditions of service of its members.

Clause 18 Section 33 reads as follows:

33. (1) Subject to the approval of the Council of the Government, the Council of the Government may, in the exercise of its powers, do all such things as may be necessary or expedient for the purposes of the Act.

(2) Where any law or charge is withdrawn pursuant to subsection (1), such law or charge shall have effect notwithstanding section 23 of the Act.
