

Mr. Mann was introduced and on behalf of the Maritime Transportation Commission stated the position of the maritime provinces with regard to the bill. Following Mr. Mann's examination Mr. Darling was questioned concerning the interdepartmental Committee on transportation.

Mr. Frawley was called and presented the views of the Government of the Province of Alberta with respect to the measure, and criticized the presentation of the Canadian Trucking Associations Inc.
