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It is important to remember, however, that the signature should not be placed on any document which contains a principle and/or a fact which may be true at the time it was signed, but which may later prove to be untrue. The Special Committee does not claim to be able to predict the future or to know what will happen in the future. The Committee thus recommends that the signature be placed under section 10 of a

**RECOMMENDATION**

The Special Committee recommends that the Canadian government, through the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, take all reasonable steps to establish a national program to identify and track all individuals who have been granted refugee status in Canada. This program should include a system of fingerprints and photographs of each individual, and should be designed to facilitate the identification of individuals who have been granted refugee status in Canada. The program should also include a system of tracking and monitoring the movement of individuals who have been granted refugee status in Canada, and should be designed to ensure that individuals who have been granted refugee status in Canada are not able to leave the country without permission from the Canadian government.

Canada will be of limited value if border controls are not strengthened. The Special Committee recommends that the Canadian government take steps to strengthen border controls. These steps should include the following:

- 1. Strengthening the Canadian border patrol to ensure that all individuals who enter Canada are properly screened and identified.
- 2. Implementing a national program to identify and track all individuals who have been granted refugee status in Canada.
- 3. Strengthening the Canadian immigration system to ensure that all individuals who enter Canada are properly screened and identified.
- 4. Strengthening the Canadian criminal justice system to ensure that all individuals who enter Canada are properly screened and identified.
- 5. Strengthening the Canadian military to ensure that all individuals who enter Canada are properly screened and identified.
- 6. Strengthening the Canadian intelligence agencies to ensure that all individuals who enter Canada are properly screened and identified.
- 7. Strengthening the Canadian diplomatic corps to ensure that all individuals who enter Canada are properly screened and identified.
- 8. Strengthening the Canadian economic system to ensure that all individuals who enter Canada are properly screened and identified.
- 9. Strengthening the Canadian social welfare system to ensure that all individuals who enter Canada are properly screened and identified.
