

SENATE RULES

EXISTING

In all cases not provided for hereinafter, the rules of the Senate shall be those of the House of Representatives, as they may be amended from time to time, and as they may be applied to the Senate or any committee thereof.

PROPOSED

In all cases not provided for hereinafter, the rules of the Senate shall be those of the House of Representatives, as they may be amended from time to time, and as they may be applied to the Senate or any committee thereof.

This resolution does not provide reference to the great Parliamentary authorities such as the Manual of the Senate and the Canadian Parliamentary Manual, but it is necessary to refer to the laws of the House of Representatives.

1. Except so far as it is expressly provided, these Rules shall in no way restrict the powers in which the Senate may exercise and defend its powers, privileges and immunities.

2. Any rule or part thereof may be amended without notice by the unanimous consent of the Senate, the vote or part thereof proposed to be amended being duly stated.

3. All existing rules and Standing Orders of the Senate are repealed, except as otherwise ordered by the Senate.
