By the advice of the British Save the Children Fund we are sending over money to start "feeding-kitchens" for children in the British area. By advance subscriptions the first Canadian Kitchen was opened in Cologne yesterday. We felt that this support of the British would make a special appeal in Canada. 150,000 people in Cologne need feeding.

I am enclosing a copy of the recent "British Appeal for Relief in Germany". You will notice that it is signed, *inter alios*, by Bisquith and Ramsey MacDonald. We felt that it might be well to repeat this as the basis of our own appeal, and to add that we felt confident that as Canadians had stood behind Britain in the war, so they would desire to support Britain in her work of humanity.

We are particularly anxious to promote the spirit of international goodwill, and feel that this campaign affords an opportunity for stressing the high moral and spiritual purpose. Your name will be an immense help in silencing prejudiced & ignorant criticism. Yours faithfully, C.P. Pitcher
