With respect to the particular dispositions of the respective armies, I doubt not but you will receive, by the same conveyance, a more accurate account, than I can assume to give you : but I can be tolerably perfect as to the action.

The enemy continued a brifk fire at a diftance, while ours was kept in referve. ---The centre, commanded by General Wolfe in perfon, having fired no more than twice, before the French fenfibly experienced the fharpnefs of their bayonets: And the Highlanders difcharging their pieces, fell in fword in hand, *indeed very unpolitely*, and made a havock not to be defcribed.---A total rout enfued
