The True Policy

If our evangelistic work is weak, as undeniably it is, our educational work is in good position. Our policy, than, must be to push on our educational operations hy every means in our power in order to more effectual evangelism. Nothing will diesipate ignorance hut knowledge; nothing will dispei darkness hut light; nothing will overcome error but truth, and the truth must prevail. Then, amidst diecouragements many and great, in the spirit of our hrethren of other missionary societies, in the spirit of our Master, iet us maintain our ground hy the side of other churches, with greater faith, earneetness and liberality than ever, in the grand enterprise of disseminating a pure Gospel throughout the whole land.
