Monthly Crop Report Said to Be Under Discount -- Locals Firm in Sections.

The only dark spot to the local stock situation to-day was a further weakness in the Steels and Coal. The more buoyant tone observed yesterday was in stronger evidence to-day, and a fair amount of outside buying was reported. The raily at New York coincided with the firmer tone here, and added to the local bull strength. Dominion Steel issues showed further liquidation, and the bonds were decidedly soft, selling down to 59, and closing with 53½ bid. Some apprehension is now felt regarding the interest on the bonds, and this accounted, no doubt, for the lower prices. The common and preferred shares were not dealt in here, but on outside markets those also held very easy. Coal sagged after the opening, but inside support was struck around 55, and a miner rally followed late in the day. N. S. Steel was again weak to-day, with a sale at 70%. This is regarded as somewhat peculiar, as the tie-up of the Dominion Steel works was mought to promise an increased output for this company. Sao Paulo was strong to-day, and advanced to the high point recently made. Other issues had a firmer tone, and sales were made at improved prices, this being particularly the case in C.P.R. The strictly investment department was dull.

At Beston to-day, Dominion Coal closed bid 53%, and Dominion Steel bid 7%.
