Extraordinary Discoveries That Have Been Made in Metropolis Laid Bare by Journalist

In Pearson's Magazine there is a com panion article to Judge Gaynor's treatise of the month preceding, on the traction trust and the "Looting of New York," by James Creeman, in which Creelman shows how "Little Old New York" is still the home of extravagant expenditure and the grafter.

"Little Old New York," thru its officers, spends more than \$200,000,000 annually, which is nearly one-third as much as the United States Government spends. Of the amount \$150,545,148 is raised by direct taxation, with the deficit met by bonded indebtedness. During the last ten years bonded indebtedness has increased \$43,025,066 annually, and but \$106,000,000 remains before the municipality reaches the constitutional limitation of debt. For the last three years a citizens' bureau of municipal research has been delving into the records. So careless are the methods employed in this great municipality that time and time again has its own real estate been sold for nonpayment of taxes, only to levoke the sale when the exact condition was discovered. Indeed, it is shown that so actioundingly loose are the methods of purchase and accountancy that distinguished experts, who have examined the situation within a few months, declare that a private business conducted in such a way would bankrupt itself in a month.
