Norman to associate with himself one or two other gentlemen as examiners, but though arrangements to this end had been made, the gentlemen who were to act with Canon Norman were unavoidably prevented from attending.

To the various collectors, Mr. Widd, Mr. McClellan during vacation; Messrs. Heneker and Wiggett in the townships; Messrs. McNaughton and Rae in Quebec, and several others in other parts of the Province, the Managers convey the expression of their obligations and tender their thanks.

Various and extensive improvements have been carried out during the past year, such as fencing, the erection of a verandah and also of a windmill pump.

Some alteration may possibly be required in the system of heating during the ensuing year as this is considered to be somewhat defective at the present time.
