From this it appears that the expenses have exceeded the receipts by \$409 87, and this sum would have been largely increased, had the new instruments recently purchased of the value of \$840 been paid for.

It will be observed that a very considerable portion of the year's outlay, viz.: \$1692 05, has been devoted to improving and repairing the condition of the hospital building; and nearly as much more will be required for the completion of the improvements now in progress.

From the Medical Report it appears that 976 in-door and 6275 out-door patients, making a total of 7251 persons, have participated in the benefits conferred by this Institution during the past twelve months.
