Murphy Now Has Four Wins — Hannah Pitches Well

The batting averages for the three senior leagues for the games to date show some keen rivalry among the hitters for premier honors. Many Fans Favor Another Title Bout For Walker

CHICAGO, June 21.—(United Press)—The middleweight wants Mickey Walker to have another chance at Pete Latzo.

Since the former champion was defeated by the comparatively unknown coal miner, the cry has gone around that Mickey had held Latzo in too tight consideration and lost the fight for this reason.

Mickey has always been a favorite to here and the populace would like to see a fight between Latzo and the Irishman in Chicago.

The talk that has gone around relative to Mickey's having seen too much of Broadway's night life and quite a bit of the "sunrise trail" on the Pacific coast is largely disbelieved here.

Mickey was not in condition during the last fight. That cannot be denied. The fact that he was the master throughout the first five rounds and that he had little trouble in hitting Latzo when he pleased and then had little to say during the latter part of the fight, proves this.

Mickey is only 29 years old, the age when he should be right in his fighting prime. He has been champion for quite a while and—right here—he is remembered that he whipped the greatest boxer of the age to gain the title.

In the course of his championship time—about four years—Mickey has fought the world's light heavyweight champion twelve rounds; fought the world's middleweight champion fifteen rounds; and has three times invaded the home-towns of some of the toughest contenders for his title; not to mention other fights.

There is no doubt but that Mickey Walker has been a real champion and if he gets into condition still is good enough to whip the rest of them in the welterweight division.

Lato really should put up a better fight next time than he did when he won the title from Mickey. The added confidence that the championship belt gives a fighter goes a long way sometimes.

But Latzo will run into a different fighter the next time he steps into the ring against Walker. Mickey has been his lesson. He'll know enough to get into condition. And with the Mick in condition Latzo will find plenty of trouble in landing his fast in anything but the ozone.

LOCAL GIRL IS STAR OF MEET, MAKING 33 PTS.

Miss Dorothy Norwood Secures Six Firsts and One Second

The sensational work of Miss Dorothy Norwood in annexing 33 points at the Maritime girls' track meet held on the Allison grounds on Saturday afternoon resulted in a win for the Trojan-Rovers over the Y. W. C. A. and other clubs. This young lady, who is also captain of the club's basketball team, won first place in the 50, 100 and 220 yard dashes, premier honors in the standing and running broad jump and basketball throw and second in the 60 yards hurdle race. Her total was just two points more than the entire amount made by the Y. W. C. A. entrants. Her club mates secured six more points.

The meet was a splendid success and a good sized crowd attended the events. The success achieved was largely due to the efforts of Miss Marion Belding, president of the M. P. B. W. A. A. F. of C., and Miss Gertrude O'Neill, secretary, assisted by many officials.
