


LAST OF MAN-EATING SAVAGES OF WHOM R. L. STEVENSON WROTE IS CAUGHT

Pago Pago, American Samoa, June 12.—(A. P. by Mail).—The capture of the last two of four wild man-eating savages who escaped from the island of New Hebrides in 1880 and landed on the island of Tutuila on a raft, ends the thirty-year dream of the island natives here for the man-eaters. The wild man was captured by an escaped prisoner who, being filled with remorse for his criminal record and being ashamed again to face his fellow man, said he took to the hills of Pago Pago where he had planned to commit suicide. While the escaped prisoner was making preparations to carry out his suicide intent, he was confronted by the black savages. The convict "got the drop" on the wild man, bound him, and held him prisoner over night. The next day the prisoner brought his savage captive to the Tutuila Naval Station here. Samoans gathered, but, apparently, fearful to attack the savage they had hunted for many years. Robert Louis Stevenson, in one of his books, told of the escape of four black recruited laborers from a German plantation in New Hebrides. The men, Stevenson wrote, fled owing to their ill treatment, and escaped to Tutuila on a raft. One was killed. The three remaining blacks haunted the bush not far from Pago Pago, towards the eastern end of Tutuila, and were occasionally seen by hunters. In the year 1900 one was caught by a young Samoan chief, and the captured savage said that one of the other two had died, leaving only one at large. This is the man who has just been brought in.

MORNING NEWS OVER THE WIRES

Next Sunday, July 29, will be observed in Canada as Peace Sunday. Many requests for literature have been received by the League of Nations Society in Canada. Harold Seary, who belongs to Medford, N. S., was saved from drowning in the Shipody river on Saturday by Captain Clare Robinson of the lighter Blackbird. Seary, a sailor on the schooner Lena, was on the way back to the schooner; he had too much canvas spread and the boat capsized. He was thrown into the water when those on the lighter saw his predicament and threw a line to him. The provisions with which the small boat had been heavily loaded were lost. Former Premier Arthur Meighen spoke last night in North Sydney in the interests of the Conservative candidate, R. H. Butts, who is contesting the federal by-election in Cape Breton North and Victoria. About 1,000 people were present.

A match carelessly thrown away in the cabin of a motor boat occupied by three men named Cheeseman, Deady and O'Neill the first two of St. Mary's Nfld., and the last of St. John's, nearly cost the men their lives. An explosion blew the boat to bits and the men escaped, badly burned, in a dinghy. They are now in hospital with severe burns about the face and hands. A divorce from her husband, Captain Robert E. Treman, has been granted Irene Castle Treman, famous dancer. The divorce was granted in Paris.

Of the forty-one insane convicts who escaped on Sunday night from the State Hospital for the Insane at Chester, Ill., fifteen had been recaptured last night. In the British House of Commons yesterday J. Ramsay MacDonald, Leader of the Opposition, moved a resolution to convene an international conference to discuss the limitation of armaments. It was rejected by a vote of 286 to 169.

The resignation of Sir Richard Squires, Premier of Newfoundland, has been placed in the hands of the Governor of that colony. It is expected that Hon. W. R. Warren, K. C., will form a ministry. It is said that Premier Squires resigned because of the dissident party demands for the dismissal of the cabinet of Dr. Alexander Campbell, a native of Prince Edward Island. The Squires Government has been in power since 1919.






