ONTARIO TOUR ENDS. Mr. Borden Addresses 2,000 Persons in Brockville.

Mr. Borden's tour of Ontario ended here last night. Two thousand persons were present.

He began by comparing the standard of living in Ontario with that in Quebec.

He then spoke of the Government's policy in regard to immigration.

He concluded by saying that he was proud to have been in Ontario.

Mr. Borden proceeded to point to the great prosperity of New Ontario and its great possibilities.

He said that he had been in Ontario for many years and had seen it grow from a small settlement to a great province.

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LONGSORENMENT OF WORK.

Montreal, Aug. 29.—Upwards of six hundred longshoremen are this week practically thrown out of work on account of the labor difficulties in England, which have resulted in the cancellation and non-arrival in port this week of many of the large steamers.

Never in the history of the port, it is said by those whose daily work keeps them on the waterfront, have conditions been so bad as they are now, and it is felt that with large families to support many of the dock laborers and workers will be the real which they have to control.

"All of last week," declared a longshoreman yesterday, "we had little or nothing to do. Some of the ships going out to sea carry and the couple that came in were such small boats that they were unable to do all the work required."
