The Committee have also had before them the application of the Albert Street Church, Woodstock, and a protest against the favorable consideration of such application from the Woodstock Church. After a careful and prolonged examination of this protest in the presence of Revs. Messrs. Seeley and Ballentine, the Committee are of opinion that no insuperable obstacles exist to prevent the admission of Albert Street Church into the Association. But in view of the importance of maintaining those cordial relations which should ever exist between our churches, the Committee would strongly recommend the Association to appoint a committee of three brethren to visit and advise with the churches at Woodstock, in order that such obstacles as do exist may be removed.

The Committee would further recommend that the Committee so appointed should discharge their duty at the earliest day, and that if on the conclusion of their labors they unitedly believe it to be advantageous to the several interests involved, they be hereby authorized to extend the hand of fellowship on behalf of this Association to the Albert Street Baptist Church, and report their action to the clerk for insertion in the Minutes.
