NAVAL DEP'T BEING BESIEGED

Ottawa, Ont., Jan. 10.—The following was issued today by the Naval Department: A great number of applications from all parts of Canada are being received by the Naval Department for the discharge of men belonging to the Canadian Naval Service, and it is desired to make known that all men, entered for temporary service in the Royal Canadian Naval Forces, are being released as quickly as they can be spared. The absolute necessity of retaining certain arrangements, made for permanent staffs to do this work, will not permit of every one being released at once. In the vast majority of cases the applications for preferential treatment in regard to discharge cannot be accepted.

DROP IN CALL MONEY AT N. Y.

December Tonnage Report of U. S. Steel Corporation Showed Decrease of 750,000 Tons.

New York, Jan. 10.—There was no essential change today from the extremely professional and restricted conditions which have thus far this year governed the daily session of the stock market. The few definite developments included the December tonnage report of the United States Steel Corporation, showing a decrease of substantially 750,000 tons, and a drop in call money, which was in a supply at 3 1/2 per cent, against the week's high rate of six per cent. An index to the market's superficial character is afforded by the list of the day's most active issues. In addition to United States Steel, which represented about 20 per cent of the moderate dealings, other prominent stocks embraced the oils, sugars, milk and metals and ordinarily inactive specialties.

SHARP DECLINE IN CORN MARKET

Chicago, Jan. 10.—Sharp new declines took place in the Corn Market today, owing to announcement that removal of the ban on importations of Argentine corn was an accomplished fact. In this connection estimates were current that Argentine shipments could be laid down in New York 35 cents cheaper than domestic corn. Besides receipts there were more liberal than has been the rule of late and there was gossip that in February minimum value of holdings would be lowered. Openings prices, which ranged from half to 4 1/2 lower with January \$1.42 to \$1.43 1/2, and May \$1.33 1/2 to \$1.35 were followed by a material rally, which, however, was not well maintained. Oats weakened with corn. After opening 3 1/2 to 1/4 off with May at 99 1/2 to 99 1/2, the market recovered somewhat.
