Provided that nothing herein contained shall be taken or held to west in the grantee as reparison proprietor or otherwise any property in or title to the land gorming the bed of Weed Provided, and, in pursuance of the Irrigation Act it is hereby declared, that these presents shall not vest in the grantee any exclusive or other property or interest in or any exclusive right or privilege with respect to any lake, river, stream or other body of water, or in.
