in Our Dominion of Canada, and being composed of

The South East quarter of Section Four of the said Township,

containing by admeasurement we humaned and sixty (160)

To have and to hold the same unto the grantee in fee simple

Provided, and, in pursuance of the Irrigation Act it is hereby declared, that these presents shall not vest in the grantee—any exclusive or other property or interest in or any exclusive right or privilege with respect to any lake, river, stream or other body of water, or in, or with respect to the water contained or flowing therein, or the land forming the bed or shore thereof.
