Melvin Humphrey, of township Four, range Iwenty mine, West of the Second Meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan, in our Dominion of hereinafter called the grantee has applied for a grant of the said lands and after due investigation has been found entitled to such grant in the terms herein embodied How Ho, that by these presents We do grant unto the grantee all the Parcel or Tract of Land, situate, lying and being in the Twenty-ninth trange West of the Second Meridian, in the Broomer of Saskatchewan, in Our Dominion of Canada, and being composed of the North West quarter of Section Four, of the said township, containing by admeasurement One hundred and sixty (160) To have and to hold the same unto the grantee in fee simple **Provided,** and, in pursuance of the *Irrigation Act* it is hereby declared, that these presents shall not vest in the grantee any exclusive or other property or interest in or any exclusive right or privilege with respect to any lake, river, stream or other body of water, or in, or with respect to the water contained or flowing therein, or the land forming the bed or shore thereof.
