31st (Alberta) Battalion Order No. 102.**SECRET.**

Reference LENS Map 1/100,000.

4th October 1916.

- MOVE 1.** The Battalion complete with Transport and attached details from 5th Canadian Infantry Brigade, will march to WARLOI today, Route BOOZINCOURT - SENLIS.
- PARADE. 2.** The Battalion will parade in the Field East of the Camp, at 12.45 p.m. March 12.55 p.m. Order of March - Signals, Band, A, B, C, and D. Companies with Battalion Sections attached as already arranged.
- DETAILS. 3.** The Quartermaster will have the 5th Canadian Infantry Brigade Details paraded at the junction of the BOOZINCOURT ROAD in front of the Camp, ready to march in rear of the Battalion.
- STRICKING 4.** Tents and Bivouacs will be struck at 11.30 a.m.
- CAMP. BAGGAGE. 5.** All baggage kitchens etc. to be ready for transport by 12 noon.
- REPORTS. 6.** Marching Out States to be at Battalion Headquarters at 12.15.
- SANITATION. 7.** Officers Commanding Companies and Sections will see that their lines are left in a thoroughly clean and sanitary condition.
- BILLETS. 8.** Billetting Party, consisting of the Quartermaster and 1 N.C.O. per company; this party will report to the Town Major at WARLOI at 12.00 noon.
