WALLY Map Ref. LENS 11.	10/12 Aug. 31st.		Weather, - Cool, cloudy, and showery. In the morning the Battalion was bathed and clothing parade was held. At 4.00 p.m. verbal instructions were received from 6th Canadian Infantry Brigade for Battalion to be prepared to move at short notice to ARCHICOUNT. Map reference LENS 11. 1/00000. and in accordance with our O.O. No. 287, Battalion moved by route march from WALLY to ARCHICOUNT AREA at 7.00 p.m. Enemy aircraft were fairly active during early part of the night, but otherwise the night was quiet. The Corps Commander has awarded the unmentioned decoration. Detailed account of acts of gallantry attached. MILITARY MEDAL. 425625 Pte. J. L. HARROD. 101327 Pte. Henry William PARKER.
