1. The Battalion will parade as strong as possible tomorrow the 31st instant, and proceed to SAVILLON to take part in a Tank Demonstration.

2. Reveille will be at 3.30 a.m. and Breakfast at 4.00 a.m.

3. The Battalion will move off and pass starting point Q. 31.1.90.70 as follows:

Scouts, Signals, Headquarters, and Band	5.15 a.m.
"A" Company	5.16 a.m.
"B" Company	5.18 a.m.
"C" Company	5.20 a.m.
"D" Company	5.22 a.m.

The following Transport will accompany the Battalion and pass starting point at 5.25 a.m.

4 Cook Kitchens.
1 Water Cart.

1 Mess Cart and 1 L.C.S. Wagon.
Companies will march at 100 yards interval.

4. ROUTE. From starting point Q. 31.1.90.70, thence North East to Q. 32.1.15.15, thence N.W. to GUICHENICOURT, thence N.E. to Q. 25.1.60.70, N.W. to ROVELLES, thence N.W. to P. 11.1.10.20, West to P. 9.1.40.20, North through SAISSEVAL, North to FOURDORNOY, North to J. 20.1.20.80, thence due North to J. 8.1.40.40.

The Battalion will return by the same route.

5. DRESS. Fighting Order, without S.M. Ras and Steel Helmets. Mess Tins will be carried, strapped to Haversacks on the back.

6. Scout Officer will send Scouts ahead to locate a rendezvous, approx. J. 8.1.40.40.

7. "A" and "D" Companies will carry four Lewis Guns and pans per Company, which will be carried by limbered wagon. Guns and pans will be packed on limbered wagon at Battalion Orderly Room by 4.45 a.m.

Six flags will be carried by Signal section.

8. Men will carry haversack rations and tea will be served directly after demonstration.

Arrangements will be made for the four Company cooks and necessary cooks to proceed with the Battalion, and have sufficient fixies filled with water before leaving.

9. There will be no exemptions, and all duties are to be out down. Company Commanders: Batmen will act as runners to Coy. Commanders.

10. Officers commanding Companies will send luncheons for their use to Bn. R. Q. Mess, Billet B.I., by 5.00 a.m.
