The 4th Canadian Division, 10th Canadian Infantry Brigade on Right, 12th Canadian Infantry Brigade on Left, and 11th Canadian Infantry Brigade in Reserve, will attack through this Division at 8.00 a.m. this morning, final objective being HALLENCOURT inclusive, HALLO inclusive, ROAD JUNCTION A.16.b.7.7. Other troops are attacking on both flanks of 4th Canadian Division.
2. Until further orders are received, Units of 2nd Canadian Division will remain in present locations, and the Companies will at once reorganize and refit.
3. Instructions will be issued in regard to dispositions for a defensive line for the VILLAGE of ROSIERES. The 5th Canadian Field Artillery, and attached Batteries will be in support of position.
4. Companies will at once reorganize to a state of readiness to move forward on very short notice and to go into action.
