To all to whom these Presents shall come-GREETING:

THILLES the Lands hereinafter described are Dominion Lands within the meaning of the Dominion Lands Act.

David Haymond, of Township Twenty, Range Thirty three, West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan in On Dominion of Canada, Farmer,

How From Be, that by these presents We do grant unto the grantee all that Parcel or Tract of Land, situate, lying and being in the Thirty third Range, West of the Rencipal Meridianien the Province of Sallatin Min Our Dominion of Canada, and being composed of

The North half of Fractional Section Follo of the said Township as shown upon a map or plan of Survey of the said Township, approved and confirmal at altawa, on the 25th day of March, 6.2, 1907, by Edoward Deville Surveyor General of Dominion Lands and of record in the Department of the Interior,

SAVING AND RESERVING, NEVERTHELESS, unto Us, Our Successors and Assigns, the free uses, passage and enjoyment of, in, over and upon all navigable waters that now are or may be hereafter found on Parcel or Tract of Land; also reserving all mines and minerals which may be found to exist within, upon, or under such lands, together with full power to work the same, and for this purpose to enter upon, and use and extent as may be necessary for the effectual working of the said minerals, or the mines, pits, seams and veins containing the same; and also reserving thereout and therefrom all rights of fishery and fishing and occupation said lands, and also the privilege of landing from and mooring boats and vessels upon any part of the said lands and using the said lands in connection with the rights of fishery and fishing hereby reserved, so far as may be reserved.

Provided, and, in pursuance of the Irrigation Act it is hereby declared, that these presents shall not vest in the grantee any exclusive or other property or interest in or any exclusive right or privilege with respect to any lake, river, stream or other body of water, or respect to the water contained or flowing therein, or the land forming the bed or shore thereof.
