Curran assures Safe Government. His platform is:

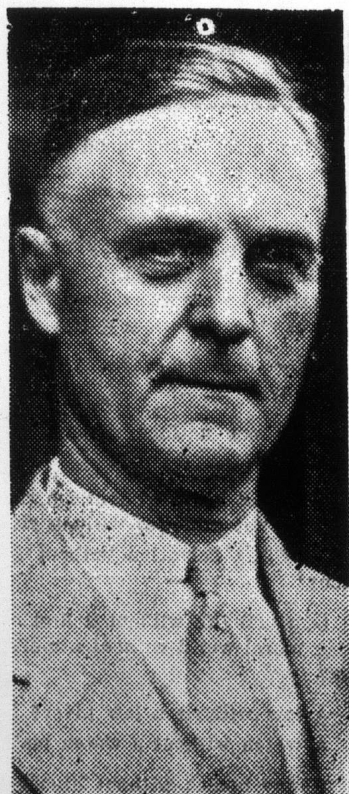
1. **TAX RATE**—Base expenditures on ability of people to pay.
