Captures Two Gold Medals

Wima Rudolph, a Tennessee Negro girl, won the women's 200-metre sprint in 24 seconds, beating out Jutta Heine, of Germany, by more than three yards, and thus became the first American woman to capture the Olympic sprint double.

She won as easily as she took the 100-metre sprint last Friday.

Discus Record Miss Rudolph, 20, has bro-

ken up an otherwise consistent pattern of Soviet victories in the women's track and field finals. Nina Ponomar-eve, the Russian who was picked up in London several years ago for shoplifting hats, scored her team's fifth victory of the seven women's events decided so far by winning the discus throw yester-day with an Olympic record toss of 55.10 metres (183 ft.,
