And whereas several types of businesses such as Banks and some Government Offices are not permitted to close unless a resolution of the Municipal Council has declared the day to be a civic and public holiday, under the provisions of The Bills of Exchange Act;

Therefore be it resolved that Friday, July 3, 1959, be, and the same is, hereby declared to be a civic and public holiday, under the provisions of The Bills of Exchange Act, and all citizens are urged to observe July 3, 1959, as such;

And further the operators of retail businesses, such as Commercial establishments, restaurants, service stations and stores are respectfully requested to grant their employees time off until 11.30 a.m. on the said day and to arrange to have staff available to serve the public, immediately following the said hour of 11.30 a.m., in order that the numerous visitors to our City may be accommodated;
