Compare Negro Plight With Jewish Problems

NEW YORK — The American Jewish community is confronted with a situation which calls for re-evaluation and readjustment of its relationship with the colored people of the world, according to Isaac Toubin, executive director of the American Jewish Congress.

In a series of talks in Pitts-

burgh, Kansas City and other Jewish communities in the Midwest last week, Mr. Toubin said that the nation's Jewish Community finds itself "untrained and inadequately equipped" to cope with swiftly moving events that effect the security of Jews in the United States and the future of world Jewry.

"At a moment in history when the world is experiencing an enormous racial, religious and political revolution — one that is having a profound influence on the status of all peoples, including the Jews — American Jewry possesses neither the necessary institutions nor the required instruments," Mr. Toubin said.

"As a result," he added, "we are unable to meet the challenge posed by the historic changes through which we are now living. Instead of acting imaginatively and affirmatively to shape the future, we do little more than react to events after they have occurred."

In a note to Dr. Marjorie L. Browne, professor and chairman of the mathematics department at NCC, Miss Spaulding said she visited Leningrad and Moscow in Russia.

After a year in Germany, Miss Spaulding will return to America to do further graduate work in mathematics at the University of Michigan as a Woodrow Wilson fellow.

Miss Spaulding, who makes her home in Durham with an uncle and aunt, Mr. and Mrs. A. E. Jackson, 715 Massey Ave., also visited in Denmark, Sweden and Finland recently.

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Negro Makes School Board

NEW HAVEN — Alphonso E. Tindall, director of the Dixwell Community House, was named to a five-year term on the City Board of Education by Mayor Richard C. Lee. He is the first Negro to be appointed to the school board.

Tindall was graduated from Lincoln University with a Bachelor of Arts degree, was on the dean's list and played varsity football.

He holds a master's degree in education from New York University and a master's degree in social work with specialization in community organization from the University of Pittsburgh. He coached high school football in Newark, N.J. At Evansville, Ind. he was boys' and men's activities director at the Carver Community Centre.

He served four years as a program director of the Soho Community House in Pittsburgh.

Tindall is president of the Dwight School PTA, where his two children, Debbie and Al Jr., attend.

He is a member of the board of directors of the NAACP, treasurer of the Friends of Ghana and associate member of the New Haven Junior Chamber of Commerce.

He is on the board of directors of the CAC, the steering committee of the Council of Social Agencies and the Dwight Area Improvement Association.

Tindall also served four years in the Air Corps during World War II, with service in India for two years.

Philosophy

"Now the colored peoples of Africa, Asia and our own United States are coming into their own, posing a problem of white-colored relationships that deeply affects the Jew."

"This is no longer a problem limited to equality for the colored men in America. It touches on the status of the Jewish communities in the Mediterranean area and has a particular relationship between Israel and the non-white states of Africa."

"The role of the Jew in America in the struggle for civil rights will thus exert a profound influence on the attitude of colored peoples in Africa and Asia toward the State of Israel."

"We shall not be serving mankind well if we become obsessed with just the business of putting new satellites into orbit — so obsessed that we overlook the fact that we have some real problems left right here on earth. We need to put new ideas — and more of them — into orbit. And we must use every resource at our command to see that people everywhere achieve greater understanding of each other before it is too late."
