U.S. Explains Stand On African Riots

WASHINGTON — (UPI) — American officials said Wednesday U.S. had no choice but to denounce South African police for slaying Negroes demonstrating against the white supremacy policy.

Silence in the face of the killing and wounding of native men, women and children would have severely damaged the moral position of the U.S. throughout the world, they said.

Officials acknowledged, too, that the contest between the U.S. and the communists for the sympathy and support of the newly awakened nations

of Africa also had much to do with the American statement recently deploring the violence against the Africans.

State Department officials were braced for an almost certain protest from the South African government against the U.S. statement, admittedly an extraordinary comment on the internal affairs of a friendly nation.

U.S. officials said they knew, when they decided to issue the statement, that it was bound to evoke an angry reaction from South Africa.

Some Easy Recipes

Sweet-Sour Corn and Beans (Serves 6)

3 slices bacon
1 onion, minced
1 No. 2 can cut green beans
1 tablespoon sugar
2 cups cooked kernel corn
1/4 cup vinegar
Salt and pepper.

Dice and brown bacon. Remove from fat and add onion to brown. Add liquid from beans and cook down to 1/3 cup. Add beans, bacon and remaining ingredients. Heat and serve.

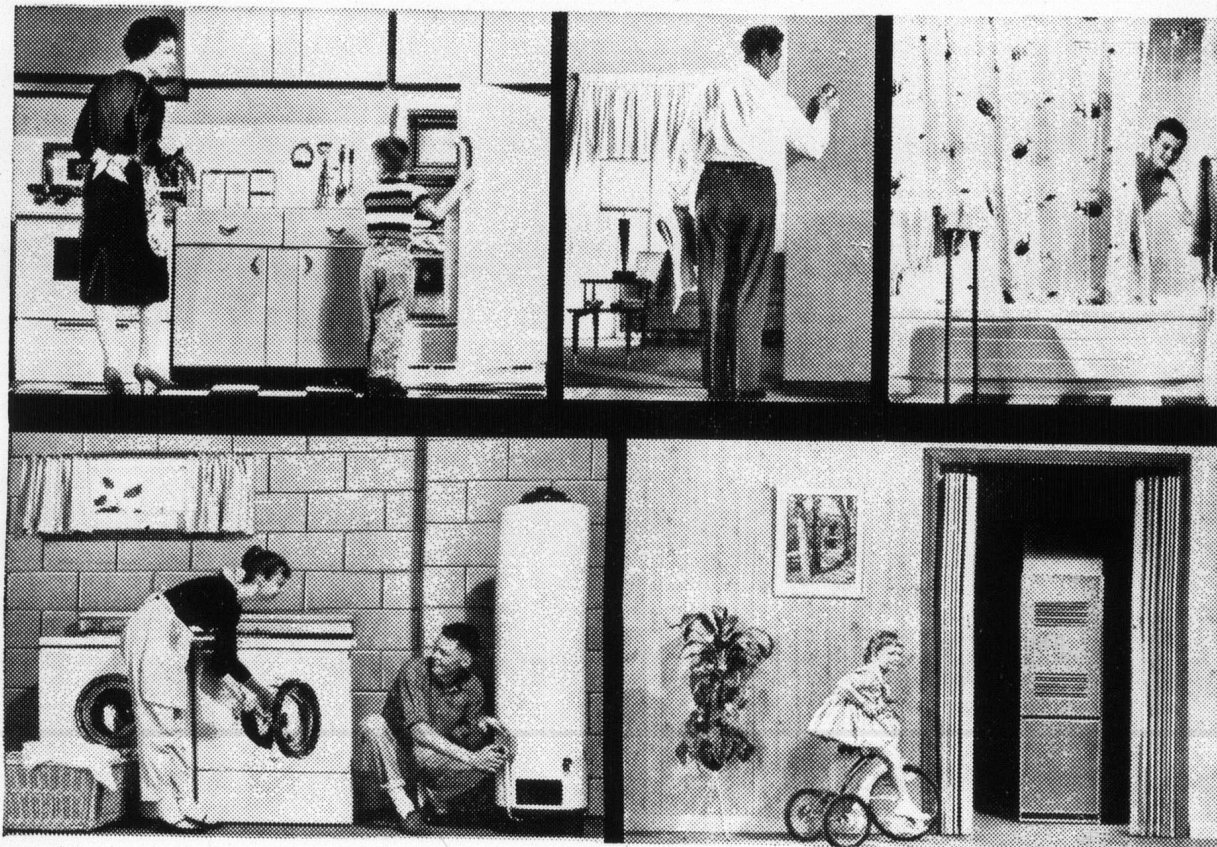
For a luscious, quickly prepared dessert, arrange chilled canned apple slices in glass dessert dishes.

Elegant dessert: make a soft custard, flavored with vanilla and almond extract. Serve over halves of cling peaches, topped with baked puffs of meringue.



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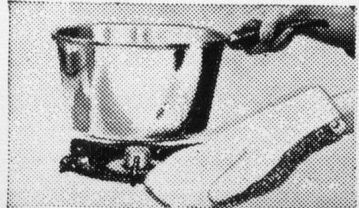
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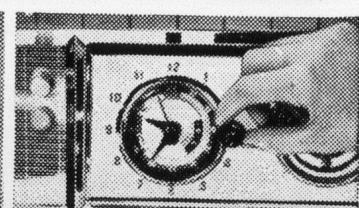
