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NOTICE STUDENTS' BUS FARES

As authorized by The Ontario Municipal Board, new regulations governing the use of Student Fares will become effective immediately

**STUDENT FARE - 7 TICKETS 25c
5c CASH**

The use of the above fares is restricted to students 17 years of age and under, attending as regular day students, one of the CITY'S Public Schools, Separate Schools, High Schools or Business Colleges.

Student fares may be purchased or tendered only by Students showing their Identification Cards issued through their Schools. Student fares may be used in conjunction with Student Identification Cards at all regular hours of service EXCEPTING AS FOLLOWS:

1. Between the hours of 4.45 p.m. and 6.15 p.m. Monday through Friday, and between the hours of 11.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturday.
2. At any time during July and August.

Student fares will not be accepted during the above restricted periods. During these periods students will be required to pay regular adult fare.

Children over 12 years of age or over 54 inches in height, will be subject to all of the above regulations.

Applications for Student Identification Cards will be made available immediately after Fair Week, through the City Schools, to all students entitled to use same.

New tickets showing the above restrictions, go on sale immediately. Old tickets will continue to be accepted, subject to the above regulations.
